

Liverpool Botanical Society trip to Ben Lawers Friday 6th July 2012 to Monday 9th July 2012

Following last year's fully booked visit to Ben Lawers it is decided to run the trip again with new participants being given precedence. The party shall number no more than 18 people, including leader

It is proposed that the mountain plants field trip takes place on the weekend of 7th and 8th July 2012. Members travelling from the Liverpool area on Friday 6th, returning on Monday 9th July.

The main travel options are car-sharing and rail. There are two possible options for train travel from Liverpool. Each involves three stages, Liverpool to Wigan, Wigan to Glasgow Central then Glasgow Queen Street to Crianlarich. Members with cars in Killin could ferry people from Crianlarich. There are also four buses a day from Crianlarich to Killin. Transport times would need to be checked nearer the time.

Killin, at the south-western extremity of Loch Tay, is the obvious base for this trip. There are numerous small hotels, guest houses, cafes and restaurants in Killin, details can be viewed at <http://www.roomfinderscotland.co.uk/mapsearch.php?townid=150> .

The Killin Hotel makes a suitable large venue to stay and dine; however, members are asked to make their own bookings with their venue of choice.
